To develop methodologies to involve people and groups in the production of knowledge;

To foster the development of knowledge and skills necessary to navigate the complex and changing environment of current nursing practice.

To map the factors related to health and environment in order to attend to people in situations of health and illness as members of a community;

To apply the necessary methods and procedures to identify the most relevant health problems in a community;

To develop the ability to involve the participation of the community in obtaining better health;

To search for interventions, with scientific evidence, aimed at the community to improve their level of health and quality of life;

To understand the evaluation process as an integral part of the intervention, to ensure quality in the process and to measure health outcomes.
