
Completed and Continuing Tasks

Course Resources: Curriculum, course book, lesson plans, and assessment tools for course were completed. Resources are in four national languages of the partners in addition to English. They were shared to students both face-to-face and e-learners.

E-learning Materials

All the lesson videos for e-learning practice was prepared. They are total 28 videos for 7 chapter. The persentation language in videos is English, and subtitles are in five language (English, Turkish, Slovenian, Czech, and Porteguese) available.

Pilot Implementations

Within the pilot implementation online pretest was practised for fourth grade students of Special Education Teacher Training Program at Sakarya University. Pretest results showed that they need learning experiences on the teaching of health protection and promotion to individuals with ID.

Students have choosen one of the face-to-face and e-learning options. About 50 students participating face-to-face course was started at the first week of October. About 30 students participating e-learning started at the first week of December. Videos on the project's YouTube Channel have been reached about 1000 visits.

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Dissemination

Partner universities have been organized the dissemination activities. These activities are useful for sharing the results, activities, experiences, and possible suggestions to improve future work.

University of Primorska team organized a dissemination evet on 11st September 2023. The title was *Empowering Inclusivity: A Multidisciplinary Approach to Curriculum Development for Health and Well-being in Intellectually Disabled Individuals».*



Politecnico da Guarda (IPG) team were organized a dissemination event on 22nd November 2023. Professors in Special Education from different universities (Seville University, Granada University, Navarra University, and Almeria University), and teachers of future students from different universities (Polytechnic of Viseu, Polytechnic of Castelo Branco, Polytechnic of Guarda) participated in the event.







Masaryk University team organized a dissemination event 29th November 2023. A total of 41 experts and several dozen students participated. The topics in the event are including;

- The protection, development and education in the field of health of people with ID,
- Interventions in the field of physiotherapy, occupational therapy and the Bobath Concept for people with ID,
- Feeding difficulties in children with ID, views of experts and parents,
- Sports and leisure activities and motor development of people with ID, and ASD,
- Sexuality in people with ID healthy sexuality, education, and programs.





Sakarya University and Duzce University teams will organize the dissemination events after pilot implementations.
